Previous minutes

1. The minutes of 21 February 2023 were agreed.

Business Programme

2. The Bureau considered and agreed to propose to the Parliament a revised programme of business for the week commencing 27 February and a programme of business for the weeks commencing 6 and 13 March 2023.
3. Neil Bibby reiterated his party's request for Ministerial Statements on both National Treatment Centres and NHS Tayside, which were supported by Alexander Burnett. Alexander Burnett reiterated his party's request for a statement on teachers' strikes, which was supported by Neil Bibby.
4. Alexander Burnett requested extra time be allocated for the Ministerial Statement on the Deposit Return Scheme. This was not agreed to.
